- Article 39 of the EU treaty specifies the objectives for a common Agricultural policy
- The latest CAP reform was decided 2013 and implemented 2015
- Since then (view of EU)
 - Agricultural prices have fallen substantially and market uncertainty has increased
 - The emphasis of trade negotiations has moved more visibly from multilateral to bilateral deals
 - new international commitments,
 - climate change
 - UN's Sustainable Development Goals – SDGs)
 - geopolitical developments (large-scale migration)

CAP: Modernising and Simplifying the Common Agricultural Policy



- 322 916 submissions (in 2010: 5700!!)
- 1 423 position papers
- 58 520 replies to the online questionnaire:
 - 21 386 farmers (36,5%)
 - 27 893 other citizens (47,7%)
- 9241 organisations (15,8%)
 - covering private companies, public authorities, trade, business or professional organisations, NGOs and platforms, and research and academia.
