


Political Map (12 regions)








Relief in Slovenia









Natura 2000 sites in Slovenia

Slovenia is characterised by extremely diverse

relatively well preserved nature small territory -great biodiversity attributed to the convergence of various types of climate, geologic features and a considerable elevation range and also to largely traditional agricultural land use

App. 60% of the environment is in a natural or seminatural state, including landscapes and areas that were managed in a traditional way in the past

Slovenia has biodiversity with 26 000 known estimated total of 45 000-120 000 species **about 800 animal and 66 plant** species are endemic. Especially characteristic are forests, subterranean and water ecosystems, wetlands, the sea, alpine and mountainous areas, and dry grasslands

0.004 % of the Earth's total surface and 0.014 % of its total land area more than 1 % of all known species of all living organisms more than 2 % of all terrestrial species live in Slovenia This ranks the country among the naturally richest areas of Europe and even of the world

- greatly helps to maintain biodiversity and national identity


