












- National Programme for the conservation of the native farm animal genetic resources adopted by the Ministry of Agriculture of Lithuania in 1996 and in 2006.
- The main purpose of this programme was collection, investigation and conservation of Lithuanian farm animal genetic resources.











- The Ministry of Agriculture adopted an order about the foundation of the Coordinating centre (Centre) for the National Programme of the conservation farm Animal Genetic Resources.
- The national farm animal Genetic Resources Coordinating Centre was found at the Institute of Animal Science at the end of 2008.


Numbers of Lithuanian rare breed animals and their changes in 2004 to 2009
